By sharing knowledge, expertise, and facilitating the transfer of know-how across the digital divide, BAASANA programs seek to improve human conditions.

The first BAASANA conference was held during the summer of 2009 in Philadelphia. In the subsequent years, the conference was held in Eastern USA, the UK. Vietnam, and India. More regional conferences in Asia and African Countries will be hosted soon.

Scholarly papers, abstracts, proposals for the panel from all academic and applied disciplines in business, natural, social, behavioral sciences, including fields of applied humanities such as journalism, mass communication, legal studies, educational administration, health sciences, environmental engineering, and IT technologies are being invited for presentation at the conference. The Paper Submission Deadline is July 20 2022. Earlier submission is highly encouraged. Since visa formalities and travel arrangements could take months, international participants are advised to submit paper, abstracts, and panel proposals ASAP.
